



Request for all guests with dogs

Please read through the following rules and use the premises at your own risk.

The park will not accept responsibility for any accidents or problems.

In case of a problem or an accident, please talk it through with the parties involved.

By entering the park you agree to abide by the rules.

Park area in general

- When in the park, dogs must be kept on a leash with a collar or harness that cannot be pulled off.
- When using a retractable leash, be sure to lock it short and take care not to let it loose.
- Please do not leave your dog tied to anything else than the dog leash hooks provided in the park.
- Please do not leave your dog in the care of staff or other visitors as this may cause problems.
- Please do not groom your dog inside the park or take the leash off when taking photos.
- Please clean up after your dog. If your dog has marked the area, wash it off with water.
- Please be mindful of other guests, as some people do not like dogs or are allergic to them.
- Benches and tables are used by everyone, so we kindly ask you to not let your dog sit on them. If you wish to take pictures of your dog on a bench or table, please cover the surface e.g. with a cloth before letting your dog sit on it.
- Dogs that have not been vaccinated against rabies and other diseases or are currently suffering from a contagious disease are not allowed in the park.
- The park will not accept responsibility for any accidents or problems with dogs that occur in the park. In the event of damage to property in the park, you may be asked to compensate for it.
- If you fail to abide by the rules and regulations or fail to follow the instructions given by the staff you may be asked to leave the park. In such case, any fees will not be refunded.

Shops

- When entering the park's shops that allow dogs, please ensure that your pet is in a carrier bag or stroller that covers the dog completely. Dogs are not allowed inside the shops only on a leash.
- All dogs, with the exception of assistance dogs, are not allowed inside any of the restaurants. Please use the terrace tables outside when dining with your dog.

Character Greetings

- When taking photos, either place your dog in a stroller, keep the leash short or carry them in your arms.
- The characters will not be able to directly interact with the dogs.

Kokemus

There are eight photo spots set amidst the displays of the exhibition 'Nature of Moominvalley' on the 3rd floor of Kokemus, where you can take pictures of your dog in the settings of the Moomin stories.

- Dogs can be put down to sit on the photo spot stand for taking pictures.
- Only dogs weighing less than 25 kg inside a carrier bag, stroller or a securely fastened sling bag that covers the dog completely are allowed to inside the building.
- Please use the elevator to go to the exhibition on the third floor and follow the instructions there.
- When on the first floor, please make sure the stroller or carrier bag covers your dog completely.
- Please note that there are loud noises, darkness and flashing lights inside the exhibition space.

Attractions

*Guests can enjoy Little My's Attraction and Oshun Ostra theatre with their dogs.
Please note that contents may change without notice.*

- Please ensure that your dog is in a carrier bag or stroller that covers the dog completely.
- Dogs are not allowed inside when only on a leash or carried in arms.
- Please note that the number of strollers allowed inside at once is limited and you may have to wait for the next show time to enter.
- Please note that the show includes loud noises, darkness and flashing lights.
